- The University plans to organize National and Regional Webinars in various subjects due to Covid-19 restrictions.
- The University maintains its focus on the Research publications in Scopus indexed peer reviewed journals. In its PhD regulations, the University made mandatory for research scholars to publish a minimum two research publications in Scopus or Web of Science or UGC Care listed journals for the submission of PhD thesis. To maintain the existing the high *h-index* and *i-10 index*.
- The university plans to strengthen its ICT facility and encourage teachers to promote online interactions with the students on their respective subject areas to keep the students updated. To advice teachers to develop e-content in their respective subjects to facilitate the Online mode of teaching. Further, to insist the teachers to record their online classes so that the recorded lectures may be shared with the students.
- To encourage the teachers to utilize e-resources available in the library and other public domains and also encourage the students to make use of the available resources.
- To encourage the students to utilize the Online resources such SWAYAM and MOOC portals to select and register for various courses through online mode and earn additional credits.
- To strengthen the facilities available in the hostels and maintain complete hygiene in view of the Covid-19 pandemic.
