Outcome-based education (OBE) is a framework that focuses on delivering acquired skills and outcomes aligned with the university's vision and mission. It increases academic success and reduces dropout rates. The university offers a student-oriented education through curriculum redesign, instructional resource selection, teaching techniques, and evaluations. Course outcomes are defined with objectives and are evaluated through internal assessments. Programs are defined as specializations or disciplines, with co-curricular and extra-curricular activities to help students achieve goals and earn degrees. Program outcomes are based on graduates' career goals, with most P.G programs having their own outcomes.
